

The 2010 Capital One National Junior Golf Academy Scholarship

To qualify for the 2010 Capital One National Junior Golf Academy Scholarship, applicants must:

- Demonstrate financial need
- Be graduating seniors enrolled in a Greater Toronto Area high school
- Have commenced their grade 12 year with a minimum grade of 70% and maintain or improve this grade throughout the first semester
- Possess leadership qualities and demonstrate the ability to overcome obstacles
- Possess previous volunteer, community outreach experience and/or have participated in extra curricular activities.
- Have the desire and dedication to become positive and productive adults
- Serve as volunteers in the National Junior Golf Academy program and or events after their scholarship has been approved
- Maintain minimum 3.0 grade point average (at the discretion of the National Junior Golf Academy board)

Completed applications must contain the following information and be received by **Monday, May 3, 2010:**

- A completed Capital One National Junior Golf Academy Scholarship application form
- A current high school transcript
- Three letters of recommendation (one letter should be from a teacher, guidance counselors or school administrator, one from a parent/guardian and one from someone in the community who can provide details on the students' extracurricular involvement and overall character)
- Statement of financial need detailing all income sources and anticipated expenses for the first year of school. Supporting documentation verifying your parent's annual income is required to be submitted (i.e. Income Tax return, T-4's, pay stubs, job letter confirming income).

Capital One National Junior Golf Academy Scholarship winners will be announced in June 2010.
